- Plan machining by studying work orders, blueprints, engineering plans, materials, specifications, orthographic drawings,
 reference planes, locations of surfaces, and machining parameters; interpreting geometric dimensions and tolerances (GD&T).
- Program mills by entering instructions, including zero and reference points; setting tool registers, offsets; calculating requirements, including basic math, geometry, and trigonometry; proving part programs.
- Set-up mills, vises, tools, attachments, collets.
- Maintain specifications by observing drilling and cutting, taking measurements; detecting malfunctions; troubleshooting
 processes; adjusting and reprogramming controls; replacing worn tools; adhering to quality assurance procedures and
 processes.
- Maintain safe operations by adhering to safety procedures and regulations
- Maintain equipment by completing preventive maintenance requirements; following manufacturer's instructions; troubleshooting malfunctions; calling for repairs.
- Maintain continuity among work shifts by documenting and communicating actions, irregularities, and continuing needs.
